

Clarification of Course Credit in SCIENCE

Students must complete 20 credits in science to graduate, 10 in Life Sciences and 10 in Physical Sciences. Some sciences overlap the two areas, depending on the focus of the course. Many 4-yr. colleges require lab science courses and recommend 3 years (30 credits) of science.

Any of several branches of science that deal with living organisms (including those no longer living) and their organization, life processes, and relationships to each other and their environment.
